Similar to the traditional growing regions of southern France, Tasmania's maritime climate and soils are well suited to growing lavender, one of the world's most valued, universally used and prescribed essential oils. With such a uniquely beautiful and distinctive aroma, true French lavender, *Lavandula angustifolia*, has been used since ancient times for its delicate perfume as well as its medicinal properties.





Tasmania has a long history of cultivating superior quality *Lavandula* angustifolia, using plant selections that were first brought to Tasmania from France in the early 1900s. Over the past 10 years, EOT has completed a rigorous selection program to produce and establish Tasmanian Lavender, a plant with an exceptionally fine fragrance, which is now recognised as its own distinctive sub-species.

With a major crop expansion program currently in place, EOT will soon be positioned as one of the largest producers of this premium grade essential oil in the southern hemisphere.
